#### Payment

- Full payment must accompany registration. Debit, Visa or MasterCard accepted only on Registration Days.

#### Late Registration

- \$25.00 charge will apply to registrations received after October 15, 2009.

#### Cancellation

- Refund requests only considered for medical or exceptional reasons and must be made in writing along with supporting documentation. The Board reserves the right to deny refunds.
- Skate Canada membership fee is non refundable or transferable.
- \$40.00 administration fee shall apply for approved refunds.

#### Transfer Request

- \$10 transfer fee shall apply for all session change requests after skating starts. No fee shall apply for skaters graduating to a higher level.

#### Partial Membership

- Non-members registering for any session, OR members registering for less than the minimum required sessions, will be assessed a fee of \$50.

#### Guest Skating

- Club member or non-member \$10 / hr and paid in advance. Skater must log in.
- No guest skating allowed one week prior to test days, or competitions.
