Payment

- Full payment must accompany registration. Cash, cheque, debit, Visa or MasterCard accepted. Cheque payable to King City Skating Club.
- \$25.00 administration fee for returned cheques.

Late Registration

- \$25.00 charge will apply to registrations received after October 15, 2008.

Cancellation

- Refund requests for medical or exceptional reasons must be made in writing along with supporting documentation. The Board reserves the right to deny refunds.
- Skate Canada membership fee is non refundable.
- \$40.00 administration fee shall apply for approved refunds.

Transfer Request

- \$10 transfer fee shall apply for all session change requests after skating starts. No fee shall apply for skaters graduating to a higher level.
- Membership is non-transferable.

Partial Membership

- Non-members registering for any session, OR members registering for less than the minimum required sessions will be assessed a fee of \$50.

⇒ Club Rules ⇒

- CSA approved hockey helmets and gloves/mitts are mandatory for all CanSkaters up to and including Stage 4. NO BICYCLE HELMETS ALLOWED.
- Except for Parents & Tots, parents are NOT ALLOWED on the ice unless volunteering.
- Please contact coaches off the ice, not during group or private lessons.
- Please use assigned dressing rooms for changing skates.
- Only Registered Skate Canada members are allowed on the ice during the session.
- No refunds or make-up days for any missed sessions, due to illness, inclement weather etc.
- The Club reserves the right to alter or cancel programs
